

# ACTIVITIES - Spring Term 2012

Contained within is a list of Activities to be offered next term to pupils in the Preparatory School together with an application form. When you and your child have decided upon the Activities he or she would like to participate in please complete page three and return it to Mr Roddis **by Friday 9th December**. If you retain Page Two it will give you a record of the programme.

For many of the activities there is no charge, but for those taken by an "outside" coach the charge for the term is shown in bold type. Please note that this charge **will be payable** even if your son or daughter decides not to continue with the Activity.

**Payment** for activities is in arrears and charges will appear on the bill at the end of term. Whilst every effort is made to keep to the prices shown, where activities are being taken by a non-West Hill member of staff, prices cannot be guaranteed.

**Swim Squads 1 & 2** are designed to offer stroke development for improvers and competitive training to advanced swimmers and they are not appropriate for all pupils.

**Fly-tying:** This activity builds on the Fly-fishing and Fly-tying activities in the previous terms. If your child is considering joining this Activity it is worthwhile talking with Mr Malleon. Priority will be given to those who have taken part in the activity previously

**Golf:** Lessons will be coached by Neil Williams, the PGA professional at Quindell Golf Club. The lessons will incorporate a variety of activities to develop driving range and course skills.

**Judo:** Coaching will be taught by Marc Thompson who is the Head Judo Coach at Winchester College.

**Information Technology:** Mr Adam will open the IT Suite for pupils to work there at the following times:

**Morning Break:** Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday

**Activities 5:30-6:15: Monday and Friday**

The ICT Rooms are open only at first break on the days shown above and will not be open at lunchtime. The Computer Club on Mondays and Fridays at 5:30 is an additional opportunity to develop IT skills.

**Young Magician:** This is a new club aimed at developing a comprehensive understanding of Magic. Whether your aim is to learn 5 or 6 easy to master yet incredibly effective tricks, or you want to build a repertoire and all round performance in a term, this activity will leave you with the ability to perform close up magic confidently to your audience.

**Fencing:** This activity is open to all ages. If your son or daughter is interested, it is a very good opportunity to take up a very interesting minority sport.

**Shell & Lovers School Play:** It will be possible for pupils to take part in an additional Activity on a Thursday as participants will not be required for every session.

**Squash:** Lessons will be coached by Abshot's resident squash instructor. The lessons will develop fitness, individual skills and match play.

**Ballet, Tap & Creative Dance:** These are three new activities and they are a great introduction to physical exercise. In addition, they help develop key skills, such as coordination, balance, flexibility, strength, stamina, discipline and even memory. Being active in this way also helps boost a child's self-esteem, make them feel good about their own abilities and increase their self-confidence.

**Over-subscription:** *On occasions, an activity is over-subscribed. If this occurs, priority is usually given to Boarders and older pupils, as younger ones will have the opportunity in the future.*
